

Leslie E. Broline, DDS, MS

Dr. Broline was born in San Antonio, TX and educated at Southwest Texas State University (B.S. 1970), University of Texas Dental Branch in Houston (DDS, 1972) and University of Texas School of Post-Graduate Dentistry (Periodontics, 1974). After serving in the USAF at Lackland AFB, Tx. (1974-76) as Base Periodontist, he started his private practice in 1976. He completed his Board Examination process in 1981, at which time he was awarded Diplomate status.

Dr. Broline has heavily participated in organized Periodontics by serving essentially all offices and committees in the Southwest Society of Periodontics (President, 1985-86), the Texas Society of Periodontists (President, 1981-83). He served the Academy of Periodontology a total 12 years on the Nominating Committee for the American Board of Periodontology.

In 2000 Dr. Broline enrolled in the Microsurgical Training Institute in Santa Barbara, CA. under the tutelage of Dr. Dennis Shanellec, the originator of the use of the operating microscope in periodontics. He has returned to Santa Barbara many times to continue training, and was asked to join the Dentorati Study Club in 2006. This study club meets two to three times a year to further their expertise in microsurgery and implant dentistry. Their group recently contributed to Carranza's Clinical Periodontology, 10th Edition.

Dr. Broline is also an active participant in the Academy of Microscope Enhanced Dentistry, having served as chair of the Corporate Liaison Committee for two years.

Dr. Broline enjoys a full time practice in Austin, limited to microscope enhanced Periodontics, with emphasis on esthetic periodontics and dental implants.

The title of the lecture is "You must see well what you do to do well what you see."
